SANDSTONE	<i>Sedimentary rock that resembles concrete</i>
MARBLE	<i>Metamorphic rock formed from the igneous rock granite</i>
SHALE	<i>Metamorphic rock formed from the sedimentary rock sandstone</i>
GNEISS	<i>Sedimentary rock also known as mudstone</i>
BASALT	<i>Igneous rock with holes and can float on water</i>
CONGLOMERATE	<i>Sedimentary rock formed from sand</i>
PUMICESTONE	<i>Igneous volcanic rock with small crystals made when lava cools</i>
GRANITE	<i>Metamorphic rock formed from limestone and used for sculpture</i>
QUARTZITE	<i>Sedimentary rock made from shells and coral</i>
LIMESTONE	<i>Igneous plutonic rock formed when magma cools slowly</i>
SLATE	<i>Metamorphic rock formed from shale and used for tiling</i>
